I'm a good person, I don't curse or steal. I go to church on Sundays and Holy Days. So, why do I need to go to Confession?

As the apostle John says, "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." The Lord himself taught us to pray, "Forgive us our trespasses" linking our forgiveness of another's offenses to the forgiveness of sins that God will grant us. It is in discovering the greatness of God' love that our heart is shaken by the horror and weight of sin, and begins to fear offending God and being separated from him. 


