#### The vocation of humanity is to show forth the image of God and to be transformed into the image of the Father's only Son...

Love of neighbor is inseparable from the love for God. Society is a requirement of man's nature. Through exchanges with others, mutual service and dialogue with his neighbor, an individual develops potential. Each person is an "heir" to past knowledge and through genetics is given special talents, which she/he is expected to use for the betterment of the society; that same society which has helped to develop the qualities of a person, especially the sense of initiative and

responsibility.

And there is that word again. Responsibility. We are made steward of our talents with the expectation that they will be used for the glory of God and the betterment of humanity. It is necessary, then, to appeal to the spiritual and moral capacities of the human person and to the **permanent** need for his *inner conversion*. We must therefore be aware of our on-going need for "inner conversion." To become fully aware is our task; to achieve this task we must know what God expects, and be willing to admit to our

failings.

Without the help of God's grace, people would not know how to "discern the narrow path between cowardice which gives in to evil, and the violence which under the illusion of fighting evil only makes worse." This narrow path is the path of charity, that is, the love of God and neighbor. Charity is the greatest social commandment. It respects others and their rights. Charity requires the practice of justice, and it alone makes us capable of it. Charity inspires a life of self-giving.

So what is Charity? Charity and Love assumes respect for persons, for their fundamental and inalienable rights to fulfill their vocation, to develop their potential and talent; it assumes the well-being of each individual and of their needs including food, clothing, health, work,

education, culture, suitable information, the right to establish a family, etc., and it assumes peace, the stability and security of a just order. To ensure the fulfillment of Charity, each one of us

needs to be stewards of our talents, and aware of failings that dis-respect persons.
