### Unfailing Light

A simple psalm-prayer: "Father, creator of unfailing light, give that same light to those who call to you. May our lips praise you; our lives proclaim your goodness; our work give you honor, and our voices celebrate you forever."

God has blessed each of us with 1,440 minutes in every day, but research shows much of our time goes to sleeping, working and watching TV. Some say we spend 10% of our time each day to watching TV. How much time does God get?

Among those who consider themselves Catholic, many maintain that they are good Catholics because they have an active prayer life and a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. We must discover ways to remind ourselves that God is present in our daily lives. The deepest call of the human heart is to journey home to God. Prayer can show us the way. The Holy Spirit invites us, in the words of St. Paul, to "pray without ceasing." God is present to us 24 hours a day. It is our awareness of God that needs heightening. There is a saying in the *Upanishads*, the scripture of India: "If men and women thought as much about God as they think of the world, who would not attain liberation?"

In ancient times, every home had its shrine to the gods and goddess, small altar areas where sacred images were displayed. The typical home in these times has rooms for all the important activities in life, rooms for eating, sleeping, bathing, storage, etc. While our entire home is a sacred space where we pray and journey to God in different ways, a special place to pray with a Bible and a sacred image could remind us to pray often and help keep our focus on prayer.

During this Christmas season, the Advent wreath and the manger scene can be that sacred place, that teaching place for us and for our children. A place for the very young to learn about the loving Jesus who died for us. A place of reminder for the adults in the room that God so loved each one of us that he suffered and died for us, but first he came as a cooing baby like your child, or grandchild, or great grandchild.

Jesus said that God is a Spirit and should be worshiped in Spirit and Truth. As we stare into the candle flame, or the flickering lights on the Advent wreath, in silent prayer we seek to still the endless river of thoughts rushing through our minds, to find the center from which all thoughts arise, the center within, in which peace and the Divine Mystery reside. Amen, Amen and again Amen.
