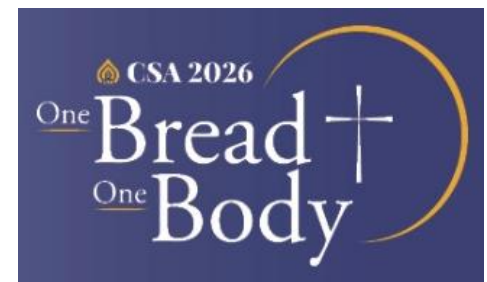
Council of Catholic Women Meeting – May 12th at 10 AM

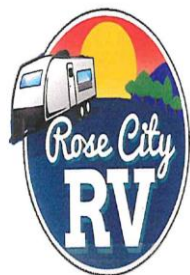

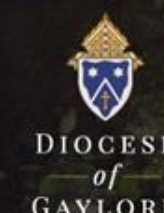
